### About Rosé

Rosé is making a comeback, now that winemakers have returned to making it using a dry style – these are not the 1970s Mateus style or 1980s California white zinfandel styles, with loads of residual sugar.

With the current styles, we find it especially fascinating to explore how different varietal characteristics are expressed in the rosé format. And winemakers are having fun with non-traditional rosé grapes too, such as the Murphy’s Law Rosé using the Austrian Blaufränkisch varietal.
